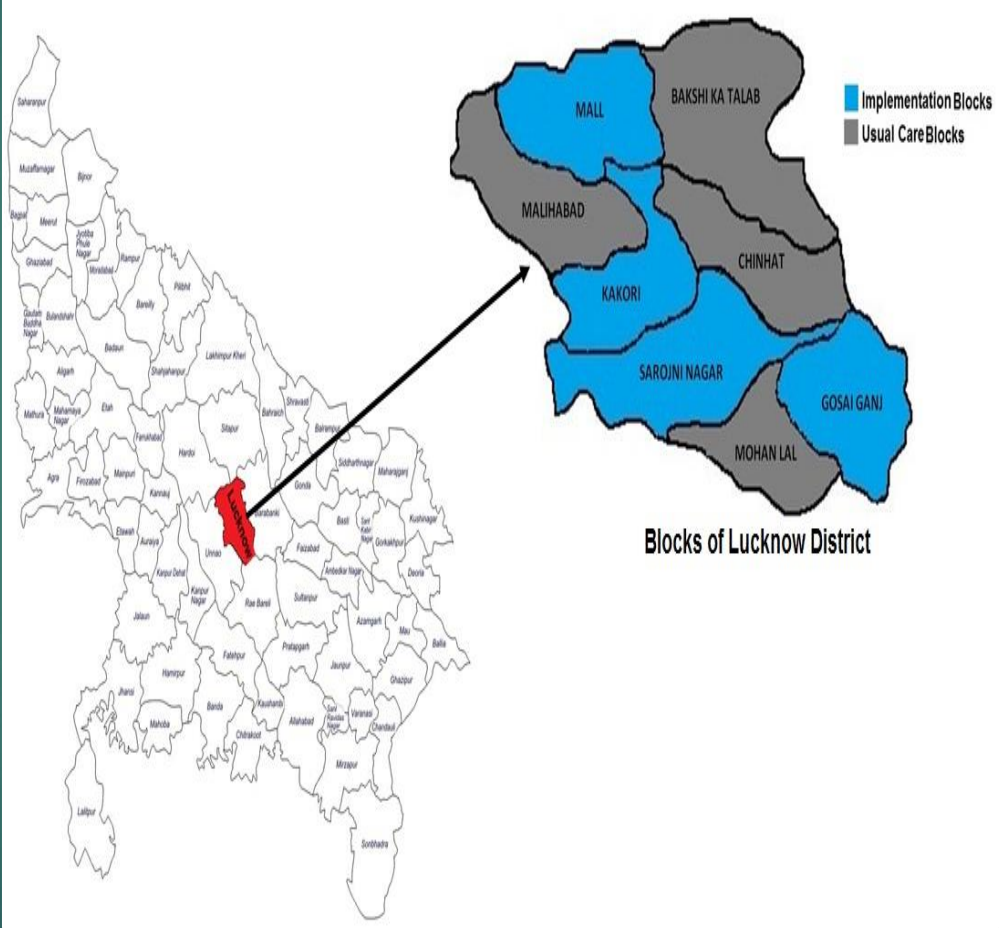

HBNC Program of GOI

- ▶ Government of Uttar Pradesh launched (HBNC) program in the year 2011.
- ▶ Under HBNC, each new-born is to be visited by ASHA on:
 - ❖ **Home Delivery:** 1st, 3rd, 7th, 14th, 21st, 28th and 42nd day of birth
 - ❖ **Institutional Delivery:** 3rd, 7th, 14th, 21st, 28th and 42nd day of birth
- ▶ ASHA provides essential new-born care which includes examination for
 - ❖ **early recognition of danger signs,**
 - ❖ appropriate and prompt referral of a sick child,
 - ❖ counselling of mother on breast feeding, warmth and immunization.
- ▶ To facilitate the working of ASHA, she is provided with a **HBNC kit**, which includes: a digital watch, digital thermometer, weighing scale with sling, blankets, drugs and consumables.

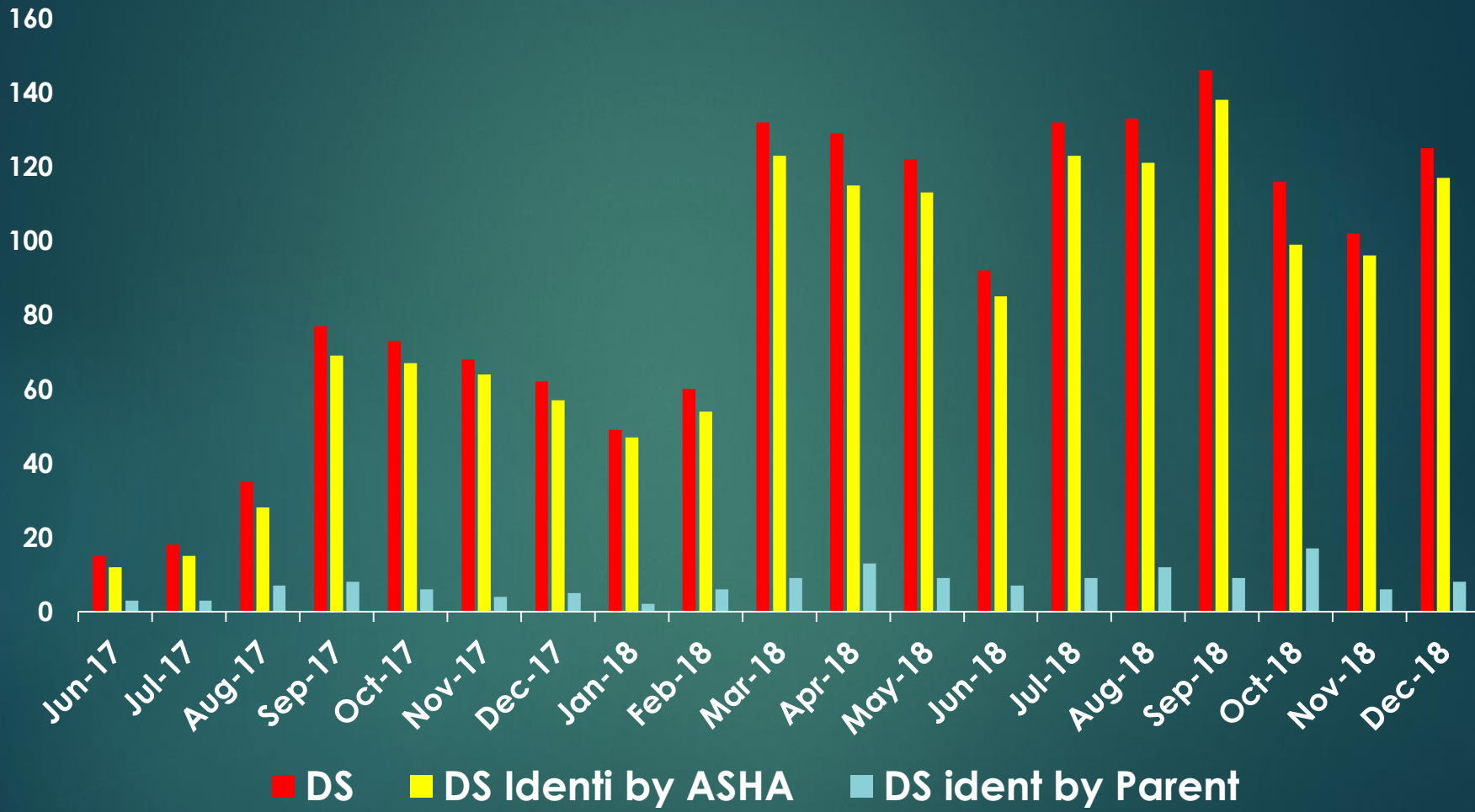
Incidence of Danger Sign and PSBI/FB cases during study period

Lessons Learned

- ▶ *Families/caregivers if supported can identify danger signs and seek appropriate care*
- ▶ *CHWs (ASHAs and ANMs) if trained can identify sick young infants, treat fast breathing and refer for appropriate care*
- ▶ *Several community based initiatives and policies in place to support PSBI management*
- ▶ *On-site hand holding of ASHA and ANMs in the field are necessary.*
- ▶ *Continuous Availability of Medicines needed in simplified treatment.*
- ▶ *Continuous motivation of doctors at CHC/PHC for support.*
